Testimony on SFY 24/25 Operating Budget Senate Medicaid Committee

Chairman Romanchuk, Vice Chair Wilson, Ranking Member Ingram, and Members of the Medicaid Committee, I want to thank you for the opportunity to submit written testimony.

My name is Erika Sterling and I am a day program coordinator for Echoing Hills. We are located in Coshocton county in Warsaw, Ohio. Our organization provides services for individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities. This includes intermediate care facilities for individuals with an intellectual disability, residential services, employment services, adult day services, and community-based waiver services administered by the Department of Developmental Disabilities.

I am in strong support of the House's budget, but more needs to be done. Low reimbursement rates are threatening our ability to hire and retain DSPs. The support provided by our organization is critical for individuals with developmental disabilities, as well as their families. Many people whom we support are unable to fully care for themselves on a daily basis. The lack of reliable DSPs can be detrimental and threaten lives of many who rely on organizations like ours.

I strongly encourage this committee to raise DSP wages to at least an average hourly rate of \$20.00. This would help us recruit and retain the workforce needed to continue to provide our quality services. With your leadership, together we can ensure these services are available to Ohioans that so greatly need them!
