Thank you for the opportunity to provide this brief, written testimony in support of the Institute for American Constitutional Thought & Leadership. My name is Rebecca Zietlow, and I am the Associate Dean of Academic Affairs, Assistant Dean for Diversity and Inclusion, Distinguished University Professor, and the Charles W. Fornoff Professor of Law and Values, at the University of Toledo College of Law.

I firmly believe that the Institute's mission—"[t]o create and disseminate knowledge about American constitutional thought, and form future leaders of the legal profession through scholarship, teaching, collaboration, and mentorship"—will enhance our students' education, enrich the academic community at the University of Toledo, and form the future leaders of Ohio through civil dialogue and discussion.
