The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Edwards was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 284 - Representatives Hillyer, Dean. Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Carruthers.

To amend section 1547.15 of the Revised Code to allow an operator of a vessel to use a rearview mirror to observe water skiers, barefoot skiers, and others who are being towed by the vessel as an alternative to having an additional person in the vessel for observation purposes.

H. B. No. 285 - Representatives Ghanbari, Rogers. Cosponsors: Representatives Cross, Troy, Hillyer, Liston, Miller, J., Carruthers, Brewer, Sweeney.

To amend sections 3333.28, 3722.01, 4723.489, and 4730.203; to enact sections 3333.27, 3722.21, 3722.22, 3722.23, 3722.24, 3722.25, 3722.26, 3722.27, 3722.28, 3722.29, 3722.30, 3722.31, 3722.32, 3722.33, 3722.34, 3722.35, 3722.36, 3722.37, and 3722.38; and to repeal sections 3727.50, 3727.51, 3727.52, 3727.53, 3727.54, 3727.55, 3727.56, and 3727.57 of the Revised Code to require hospitals to establish registered nurse staffing plans that protect patient safety, to create the Nursing Student Loan-to-Grant Program, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 286 - Representative Santucci.

To enact section 5534.655 of the Revised Code to designate a bridge spanning State Route 11 in Trumbull County as the "Vienna Township Veterans Bridge."

H. B. No. 287 - Representative Baker.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.585 of the Revised Code to create the "Terrace Park" license plate.

H. B. No. 288 - Representatives Humphrey, Miller, A.

To make an appropriation to continue to fund the Supplemental Nutrition

Assistance Program, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families programs, and Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children contingent upon a lapse in federal funding.

H. B. No. 289 - Representatives Robb Blasdel, Swearingen. Cosponsors: Representatives Richardson, Schmidt, White, Brennan, Carruthers, Rogers.

To amend sections 2950.01 and 2950.07 of the Revised Code to provide that if a Tier I or Tier II sex offender/child-victim offender fails to comply with duties under the SORN law, the period of time that the offender has a duty to comply is tolled during the time of the failure, and to make disseminating matter harmful to juveniles a sexually oriented offense and a person who violates the offense a Tier I sex offender/child-victim offender.
