The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Mathews was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 318 - Representative Swearingen.

To enact section 5534.941 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 269 in the Village of Castalia as the "Scott G. Gast Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 319 - Representatives Gross, Wiggam.

Cosponsors: Representatives Bird, Claggett, Click, Creech, Dean, Edwards, Ferguson, Hall, Holmes, John, Kick, King, Klopfenstein, Lear, Lipps, Lorenz, Loychik, McClain, Merrin, Miller, K., Miller, M., Powell, Ray, Richardson, Schmidt, Stein, Stoltzfus, Swearingen, Willis, Barhorst, Young, T.

To enact section 3792.07 of the Revised Code to prohibit discrimination against an individual for the refusal of certain medical interventions for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions, and to name this act the Conscientious Right to Refuse Act.

H. B. No. 320 - Representatives Jarrells, Pizzulli.

Cosponsors: Representatives Galonski, Brent, Rogers, Thomas, C., Miller, A., Brennan, Brewer, Denson.

To enact section 5534.964 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 125 in Scioto County as the "Al Oliver Highway."

H. B. No. 321 - Representatives Click, Lorenz.

Cosponsors: Representatives Dobos, Lear, Lipps, White.

To enact section 128.29 of the Revised Code to establish a statewide 9-1-1 special needs database.

H. B. No. 322 - Representatives Seitz, Abrams.

Cosponsors: Representatives King, Robb Blasdel, Schmidt, Carruthers, White, Miller, K., Dean, Cross.

To amend sections 2901.13, 3797.01, 3797.04, 3797.10, and 3797.12; to

enact section 2907.071; and to repeal section 3797.11 of the Revised Code to impose a civil penalty, rather than a criminal penalty, on a person who fails to register with the childhood sexual abuse civil registry, to eliminate the residence restriction on such person, to create the offense of grooming, and to extend the limitation period for prosecuting a violation of the law requiring certain persons to report child abuse or neglect under certain circumstances.

H. B. No. 323 - Representative McNally.

To amend section 1545.05 of the Revised Code to specify membership of the board of park commissioners of a park district that was a township park district created before 1892 and converted into a park district on or before January 1, 1989.

H. B. No. 324 - Representatives McClain, Klopfenstein.

Cosponsors: Representatives Bird, Brennan, Click, Creech, Dobos, Gross, Hoops, King, Lipps, Lorenz, Manchester, Miller, J., Peterson, Richardson, Williams, Willis.

To amend sections 5747.98 and 5751.98 and to enact sections 122.078, 5747.74, and 5751.56 of the Revised Code to temporarily authorize a nonrefundable tax credit for the retail sale of high-ethanol blend motor fuel.

H. B. No. 325 - Representative Upchurch.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, Brent, Brewer, Denson, Humphrey, Isaacsohn, Lightbody, Lipps, Miller, A., Mohamed, Seitz, Weinstein.

To enact sections 341.193, 753.022, and 5120.052 of the Revised Code to require municipal and county correctional facilities and state correctional institutions to provide inmates who are deaf, hard of hearing, or severely speech impaired with access to teletypewriters.

Said bills were considered the first time.
