INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 326 - Representative Abrams.

To express the General Assembly's intent to use revenue from a tax on adult use marijuana to fund peace officer training.

H. B. No. 327 - Representatives Wiggam, Swearingen. Cosponsors: Representatives Click, Creech, Cutrona, Edwards, Fowler Arthur, Gross, Hall, Hillyer, John, Johnson, Kick, King, Klopfenstein, Lorenz, Loychik, McClain, Merrin, Miller, K., Miller, M., Patton, Pizzulli, Plummer, Seitz, Stewart, Williams, Young, T.

To enact sections 4151.01, 4151.02, 4151.03, 4151.10, 4151.11, 4151.12, and 4151.13 of the Revised Code to require government contractors, private nonresidential contractors, and certain employers to use E-verify.
