To enact section 5.212 of the Revised Code to designate March 9th as "6888th Central Postal Directory Battalion Day."

H. B. No. 279 - Representative Willis.

Cosponsors: Representatives Williams, Stewart, Thomas, C., Manning.

To enact section 4511.773 of the Revised Code to require occupant restraining devices to be installed on all school buses within five years.
