INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 176 - Representative Grim.

To amend sections 4501.21 and 4503.53 of the Revised Code to revise the "Ohio Carpenters" license plate.

H. B. No. 177 - Representative Manchester.

To amend section 1751.12 and to enact sections 3923.811 and 3959.21 of the Revised Code to prohibit certain health insurance cost-sharing practices.

H. B. No. 178 - Representatives Brent, Callender. Cosponsors: Representatives Grim, Brennan, Upchurch, McNally, Brewer,

Hillyer, Miller, J., Thomas, C., Miller, A., Abdullahi, Brown, Young, T.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, 3328.24, and 4112.01 and to enact section 3319.48 of the Revised Code to enact the Creating a Respectful and Open World for Natural Hair (CROWN) Act to prohibit discrimination against an individual based on hair texture and protective hair styles.

H. B. No. 179 - Representatives Mathews, Stewart. Cosponsors: Representatives Hillyer, Seitz.

To amend section 2305.15 and to enact section 2307.241 of the Revised Code relative to vicarious liability in tort actions and to provide that the tolling of the limitations period during the defendant's absence or concealment does not apply to statutes of repose.

H. B. No. 180 - Representatives LaRe, Swearingen.

To enact section 9.09 of the Revised Code to prohibit a municipal corporation or charter county from imposing a curfew except in certain cases.

H. B. No. 181 - Representatives Hillyer, Williams. Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Kick.

To amend sections 317.13, 317.32, 317.321, 317.36, 1113.13, 1337.04, 2329.02, 4513.61, 4513.62, 4513.63, 4513.64, 4513.66, 4749.01, and 5323.02

and to enact section 5301.234 of the Revised Code to make various changes regarding recorded instruments, powers of attorney, judgment liens, mortgage subrogation, law enforcement towing laws, and state stock banks, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 182 - Representatives Hillyer, Barhorst. Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Holmes.

To amend sections 1321.632, 1321.68, and 1321.99 of the Revised Code regarding precomputed consumer installment loan acceleration and conversion, interest rates, refinance charges, and bona fide errors.
