The House met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to House Rule No. 23, the Clerk called the House to order.

Representative Edwards was selected to preside under the Rule.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 309 - Representatives Thomas, C., Baker. Cosponsors: Representatives Isaacsohn, Grim, Galonski, Brent, McNally, Brennan, Forhan, Robinson, Somani, Liston, Miranda, Weinstein, Lightbody, Abdullahi, Jarrells, Miller, J., Blackshear, Mohamed.

To amend section 2923.11 and to enact section 2923.26 of the Revised Code to prohibit a federally licensed firearms dealer from transferring a firearm until at least ten days have elapsed since the dealer has contacted the national instant criminal background check system and the dealer has received a unique identification number.

H. B. No. 310 - Representative Jones.

To amend sections 3307.70, 3307.751, and 3307.752 of the Revised Code regarding purchases of military service credit by State Teachers Retirement System members.

To amend section 3313.5319 of the Revised Code regarding ticket prices for school-affiliated events.

H. B. No. 312 - Representatives White, Young, T.

Cosponsors: Representatives Seitz, Johnson, Willis, Dobos, Hillyer, Grim, Hall, Plummer, Lampton, Creech.

To enact section 3301.85 of the Revised Code to establish the Regional Partnerships Program and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 313 - Representatives Callender, Mathews.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hall, Troy, Click, Seitz, Stoltzfus, Jones, Gross, Johnson, Dobos, Lear, Schmidt, Hillyer, Lipps, Loychik, Williams, Brennan.

To amend sections 109.71, 109.73, 109.75, 109.79, 109.801, and 2923.126

and to enact sections 109.7481 and 109.774 of the Revised Code to provide firearms training for fire investigators; to permit such an investigator who has received that training and has been specifically authorized to carry firearms while on duty; to grant such an investigator the same right to carry a concealed handgun in this state as a concealed handgun licensee; and to amend the version of section 109.73 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect on December 29, 2023, to continue the change on and after that date.

H. B. No. 314 - Representatives Bird, Williams.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, Click, Dean, Dobos, Fowler Arthur, Gross, Schmidt, Willis.

To repeal section 2151.271 of the Revised Code to remove the option for the juvenile court to transfer a proceeding against a juvenile to the county where the juvenile resides.

Sec. 737.061. (A) The chief of police of a municipal corporation may conduct training schools for prospective law enforcement officers. The training school programs shall align with Ohio peace officer training academy standards and offer equivalent qualification. The prospective officers, during the period of training and as members of the training school, may be paid a reasonable salary. The chief of police may furnish the necessary supplies and equipment for the use of the prospective officers during the training period.

(B) The chief of police may establish rules governing the qualifications for admission to training schools for prospective officers and provide for competitive examinations to determine the fitness of the students and prospective officers, not inconsistent with the rules of the director of administrative services.

(C) Upon completion of a training school program established under this section, a program graduate may be hired directly by the relevant department."

The motion was agreed to and the bill so amended.
