INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 369 - Representative Skindell.

To amend section 307.04 of the Revised Code to eliminate the 10-year limitation on county utility supply contracts.

H. B. No. 370 - Representative Edwards.

To amend sections 5501.31, 5521.01, and 5521.011; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 5521.011 (5521.012); and to enact new section 5521.011 of the Revised Code to clarify and amend the laws related to the Director of Transportation's responsibilities for state highways located in villages and cities.

H. B. No. 371 - Representatives Dean, Gross. Cosponsor: Representative Holmes.

To enact the Issue 1 Implementation Act.

H. B. No. 372 - Representatives Grim, Hoops.

Cosponsors: Representatives Miranda, Denson, Humphrey, Baker, Brennan, Lightbody, Pizzulli, Miller, A., Wiggam, Russo, Troy, Rogers, Liston, Isaacsohn, Weinstein, Sweeney, Miller, J., Galonski, Lipps, Brent, Skindell, Brown, Miller, K., Hillyer.

To amend sections 4511.62, 4511.63, 4511.64, and 4511.712 of the Revised Code to require vehicle operators to watch, listen, and stop for on-track equipment that may be approaching a railroad crossing.
