INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 660 - Representatives Mathews, Edwards.

To amend sections 3345.56, 3376.01, 3376.02, 3376.03, 3376.04, 3376.05, 3376.06, and 3376.07; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 3345.56 (3376.11); and to enact sections 3376.09, 3376.10, and 3376.12 of the Revised Code to revise the law governing compensation to intercollegiate athletes for use of their name, image, or likeness.

H. B. No. 661 - Representatives Klopfenstein, Daniels.

Cosponsors: Representatives Williams, Robb Blasdel, Dean, King, Click, Lear, Peterson, Kick, Claggett.

To amend sections 3314.03, 3326.11, 3328.24, 3701.132, and 3715.60 and to enact sections 3313.8110, 3345.88, 3715.601, 3715.602, 3715.603, 3715.604, 3715.605, and 5101.548 of the Revised Code to regulate imitation meat and egg products.

H. B. No. 662 - Representative Miller, A.

To amend section 2923.20 of the Revised Code to exempt certain antique firearms from the prohibition against unlawful transactions in weapons.

Said bills were considered the first time.
