INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 441 - Representatives Edwards, Miller, A. Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, Brown, Carruthers, Plummer, Seitz, Troy, Weinstein.

To amend sections 145.01 and 5149.04 and to enact section 145.336 of the Revised Code to set parole officer caseloads, to make changes to the Public Employees Retirement System law enforcement division for parole officers, and to make an appropriation.

H. B. No. 442 - Representatives Lorenz, Rogers. Cosponsor: Representative Troy.

To enact section 4521.20 of the Revised Code to require the Director of Public Safety to adopt standards authorizing persons to pay for parking meters via multiple payment methods.

H. B. No. 443 - Representatives Grim, Carruthers. Cosponsors: Representatives Miller, J., Russo, Miller, A., Baker, Isaacsohn, Skindell, Somani, Thomas, C., Piccolantonio.

To amend section 956.181 and to repeal section 956.23 of the Revised Code to alter the law governing the regulation of pet stores.

H. B. No. 444 - Representatives Miranda, McNally. Cosponsors: Representatives Grim, Brewer, Russo, Brennan, Weinstein, Denson, Upchurch, Piccolantonio, Somani, Baker, Jarrells, Abdullahi.

To enact sections 4933.51, 4933.52, 4933.53, 4933.55, 4933.57, 4933.58, 4933.59, and 4933.60 of the Revised Code to prohibit certain public utilities from recovering political expenditure costs from their customers.

Said bills were considered the first time.
