INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 377 - Representatives Williams, Santucci.

Cosponsors: Representatives Edwards, King, Hall, Johnson, Wiggam, Young, T., Click, Stein, Bird, Kick, Dell'Aquila, Lorenz, Miller, K., Creech, Carruthers, Fowler Arthur, Humphrey, Barhorst, Cutrona, Klopfenstein, Dobos, Manning, Pavliga, Schmidt, Plummer, Dean, Richardson, Demetriou, Pizzulli, McClain, Miller, M., Hillyer, Brennan, Willis, Merrin, Lipps, Rogers.

To amend sections 2903.41, 2905.01, 2905.02, 2905.32, and 2971.03 of the Revised Code to enact the Human Trafficking Prevention Act to increase the penalty for human trafficking of a minor or person with a developmental disability, kidnapping, and abduction.

H. B. No. 378 - Representatives Lorenz, Santucci. Cosponsors: Representatives Williams, Brennan.

To amend sections 323.151, 323.152, 323.153, 4503.064, 4503.065, and 4503.066 of the Revised Code to authorize a full homestead exemption for surviving spouses of members of the uniformed services killed in the line of duty.

H. B. No. 379 - Representatives Lorenz, Carruthers. Cosponsor: Representative Lear.

To enact section 5535.17 of the Revised Code to establish procedures for microchip scanning of deceased dogs or cats found on a public road or highway.

Said bills were considered the first time.
