To enact sections 4177.01, 4177.02, 4177.03, 4177.04, 4177.05, 4177.06, 4177.07, 4177.08, and 4177.99 of the Revised Code to establish sanctions for an employer that employs an unauthorized alien.

**H. B. No. 657** - Representatives Pavliga, Richardson. Cosponsor: Representative Carruthers.

To amend section 3313.602 of the Revised Code to enact the Transparency in Pledge of Allegiance "T.I.P.A." Act to require each school district to post its Pledge of Allegiance policy.
