INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 182 - Senator Reynolds.

To enact sections 3301.95 and 3333.89 of the Revised Code to establish the Foster-to-College Scholarship Program, to require the Department of Education and Workforce to hire a full-time school foster care liaison, and to make an appropriation for the Foster-to-College Scholarship Program.

S. B. No. 183 - Senator Antonio.

To enact section 5534.662 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of I-90 in Cuyahoga County as the "Lance Corporal James Patrick Rizzo Memorial Highway."
