STATE OF OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATOR COLUMBUS

Whereas, Governor Mike DeWine duly appointed John Logue to the position of the Administrator of the Bureau of Workers' Compensation; and,

Whereas, by the authority vested in the Administrator under Revised Code 4121.121(C), the Administrator, with the advice and consent of the Senate, shall appoint a chief operating officer who has a minimum of five years of experience in the field of workers' compensation insurance or in another similar insurance industry if the Administrator does not possess such experience; and,

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Whereas, the chief operating officer shall serve in the unclassified civil service of the state;

Now therefore, I hereby commission Shawn Crosby to the position of Chief Operating Officer of the Bureau of Workers' Compensation, authorizing and empowering her to execute and discharge the duties of said office, and to enjoy the privileges and immunities thereof.
