INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 314 - Senator Ingram.

Cosponsors: Senators Hicks-Hudson, Antonio, Smith, DeMora.

To amend sections 3721.60, 3721.61, 3721.62, 3721.63, 3721.65, and 3721.66 of the Revised Code to make changes regarding electronic monitoring of a resident's room in a long-term care facility.

S. B. No. 315 - Senator Johnson.

To enact section 5534.674 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 781 in Adams County as the "CPL Willard Boston Wallace Memorial Highway."
