The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 3, the Clerk called the Senate to order.

Senator Craig was selected to preside according to the rule.

The journal of the last legislative day was read and approved.

**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered for the first time:

**S. B. No. 332** - Senator Schaffer.

To create the Tri-Share Child Care Pilot Program.

**S. B. No. 333** - Senators Blessing, Ingram.

To enact sections 341.43, 753.34, 5120.052, and 5139.132 of the Revised Code to require voice communication services for inmates, delinquent children, and youthful offenders, and to make an appropriation.

**S. B. No. 334** - Senators Hackett, Schaffer.

To enact section 5534.59 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of U.S. Route 33 in Fairfield County and I-70 in Clark County as the "Congressman David Hobson Memorial Highway."

**OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS**

Senator Blessing offered the following joint resolution:

**S. J. R. No. 6**-Senator Blessing.

Proposing to amend Section 2 of Article II and Sections 1, 3, 4, and 5 of Article XI of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to increase the membership of the General Assembly to 51 senators and 153 representatives beginning January 1, 2033.

The question being, "Shall the joint resolution, **S. J. R. No. 6**, be adopted?"

On the motion of Senator Johnson, **S. J. R. No. 6**, was referred to the Committee on Rules and Reference.

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 55, the following resolutions were offered:

**S. R. No. 475** - Senator Schaffer.

Honoring the Lancaster High School girls cross country team on winning the 2024 Division I State Championship.

**S. R. No. 476** - Senator Blessing.

Honoring the Madeira High School girls soccer team on winning the 2024 Division V State Championship.

The question being, "Shall the resolutions listed under the President's prerogative be adopted?"

So the resolutions were adopted.
