INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered for the first time:

S. B. No. 317 - Senator Antani.

To amend sections 9.16, 145.11, 742.11, 3307.15, 3309.15, and 5505.06 and to enact sections 3345.161 and 5703.83 of the Revised Code to permit payment of state and local taxes and other government fees with cryptocurrency and to address investments in cryptocurrency by state colleges and universities and the state retirement systems.

OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Antonio offered the following resolution:

S. R. No. 453-Senator Antonio.

Cosponsors: Senators Craig, DeMora, Hicks-Hudson, Ingram, Smith, Sykes.

To express the Ohio Senate's support for the Citizens Not Politicians—Citizens Redistricting Commission Initiative, which would transfer the power of drawing legislative and congressional maps from politicians and lobbyists to the citizens of Ohio; to address the problems, risks, and political extremism of politician-led gerrymandering that undermines fair representation; and to encourage Ohioans to support the measure for a freer, more democratic state.
