То	amend section 909.07 and to enact sections	1
	5.2410, 5.2411, 5.2412, 5.2413, and 5.268 of the	2
	Revised Code to make specified day and week	3
	designations relating to agriculture and to	4
	modify the law governing deputy apiarists.	5

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 909.07 be amended and sections	6
5.2410, 5.2411, 5.2412, 5.2413, and 5.268 of the Revised Code be	7
enacted to read as follows:	8
Sec. 5.2410. The twenty-first day of March is designated	9
<u>as "Agriculture Day."</u>	10

Sec. 5.2411. The week beginning on the Saturday before the	11
last Saturday of February through the last Saturday in February	12
is designated as "FFA Week."	13
Sec. 5.2412. The twelfth day of October is designated as	14
"Farmer's Day."	15
Sec. 5.2413. The week ending with the second Saturday of	16
March is designated as "4-H Week."	17
Sec. 5.268. The second full week of November is designated	18
"Ohio Soil Health Week," to celebrate and raise awareness for	19
the importance of soil health to Ohio agriculture and in honor	20
of the birthday of soil pioneer and advocate David Brandt.	21
Sec. 909.07. The board of county commissioners may	22
appropriate such funds as it deems sufficient for the inspection	23
of apiaries in its county. It may appoint a deputy apiarist -	24
apiarists with the consent and concurrence of the director of	25
agriculture , said deputy to <u>.</u> A deputy shall serve during <u>at</u>the	26
pleasure of said <u>the</u> board except as specified in this section.	27
Such deputy shall be paid such salary as the county	28
commissioners determine <u>board determines</u> for each day, or for	29
each half day of inspection work actually done, together with	30
such expenses as are necessarily incurred in the doing of the	31
inspection work. Before the board approves said salary and	32
expenses for payment, such deputy shall submit the same to the	33
director for his approval. Such deputy shall work under the	34
direction of the director and shall be responsible to <u>him the</u>	35
director for the enforcement of sections 909.01 to 909.18,	36
inclusive, of the Revised Code. The director may terminate the	37
appointment of any deputy upon submitting to the board a	38
statement that such deputy has shown-himself the deputy to be	39
incompetent, inefficient, or untrustworthy in the discharge of	40

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his<u>official</u> duties. Such deputy shall furnish to the director	41
such reports as are required and upon blanks furnished by him	42
the director. A duplicate of such reports shall be presented to	43
the board each time that a statement of salary and expense is	44
presented for payment.	
Section 2. That existing section 909.07 of the Revised	46
Code is hereby repealed.	47
Section 3. This act shall be known as the Agriculture	48
