A BILL

To enact section 5534.847 of the Revised Code to 1
designate a portion of State Route 60 in 2
Muskingum County as the "Sgt Bradley J. Harper 3
USMC Memorial Highway." 4

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5534.847 of the Revised Code be 5
enacted to read as follows: 6

Sec. 5534.847. In addition to any other name prescribed in 7
the Revised Code or otherwise, the northbound and southbound 8
lanes of state route number sixty, between the intersection of 9
that route and main street, south of the municipal corporation 10
of Dresden, and the intersection of that route and state route 11
number sixteen, in Muskingum county, shall be known as the "Sgt 12
Bradley J. Harper USMC Memorial Highway." 13

The director of transportation may erect suitable markers 14

along the highway indicating its name.
