"Section 755.30. (A) As used in this section, "rural county" 21 means a county that does not contain a municipal corporation with 22 a population greater than fifty-five thousand residents according 23 to the most recent federal decennial census. 24

(B) The Connect4Ohio Program is created, and the Department
of Transportation shall administer the Program. The purpose of the
Program is to assist in creating seamless transportation
connections throughout all of Ohio and, by doing so, to make it
easier for all Ohio workers to commute from their homes to
employment centers.

(C) As part of the Program, the Department and the 31 Transportation Review Advisory Council (TRAC) shall work together 32 to provide funding for unfunded projects included on the "Final 33 2023 - 2026 Major New Construction Program List, TRAC Tier 1 -34 Construction Commitments; TRAC Tier 2 - Development Commitments; 35 TRAC Tier 3 - Development Commitments" document that was published 36 by the Department on March 29, 2023.
