#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 1505.07 of the Revised Code be	4
amended to read as follows:	5
Sec. 1505.07. (A) Subject to the limitation limitations	6
set forth in <u>division (B) of this section and in</u> section 1505.08	7
of the Revised Code, the director of natural resources, with the	8
approval of the director of environmental protection, the	9
attorney general, and the governor, may issue permits and make	10
leases to parties making application for permission to take and	11
remove sand, gravel, stone, and other minerals or substances	12
from and under the bed of Lake Erie, either upon a royalty or	13
rental basis, as <del>he</del> the director of natural resources determines	14
to be best for the state. Permits shall be issued for terms of	15
not less than one year nor more than ten years, and leases shall	16
be for a term of years or until the economic extraction of the	17
mineral or other substance covered thereby has been completed.	18

Such taking and removal shall be within certain fixed boundaries	19
that do not conflict with the rights of littoral owners. Upon	20
request from the holder of a permit, it shall be canceled, but	21
in the case of any permit or lease, any equipment or buildings	22
owned by the permittee or lessee shall be held as security by	23
the director of natural resources for payment of all rentals or	24
royalties due the state at the time of cancellation.	25
(B) Notwithstanding section 155.33 of the Revised Code,	26
the director of natural resources or any other state authority	27
shall not issue any permit or make any lease to take or remove	28
oil or natural gas from and under the bed of Lake Erie.	29
(C) No person shall remove sand, gravel, stone, or other	30
minerals or substances from and under the bed of Lake Erie	31
without first obtaining a permit or lease therefor from the	32

(D) The director of natural resources may, in accordance	34
with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, adopt, amend, and rescind	35
rules for the administration, implementation, and enforcement of	36
