## A BILL

To enact section 9.59 of the Revised Code to	1
protect individuals from being compelled to wear	2
a mask or other facial covering.	3

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

<b>Section 1.</b> That section 9.59 of the Revised Code be	4
enacted to read as follows:	5
Sec. 9.59. (A) As used in this section:	6
(1) "Place of public accommodation" means all of the	7
<pre>following:</pre>	8
(a) An inn, hotel, motel, or other place of lodging;	9
(b) A restaurant, bar, or other establishment serving food	10
or drink;	11
(c) A motion picture house, theater, concert hall,	12
stadium, or other place of exhibition or entertainment;	13
(d) An auditorium, convention center, lecture hall, or	14
other place of public gathering;	15

(e) A bakery, grocery store, clothing store, hardware	16
store, shopping center, or other sales or rental establishment;	17
(f) A laundromat, dry-cleaner, bank, barber shop, beauty	18
shop, travel service, shoe repair service, funeral parlor, gas	19
station, office of an accountant or lawyer, pharmacy, insurance	20
office, professional office of a health care provider, publicly	21
accessible area of a hospital, or other service establishment;	22
(g) A terminal, depot, or other station used for public	23
<pre>transportation;</pre>	24
(h) A museum, library, gallery, or other place of public	25
display or collection;	26
(i) A park, zoo, amusement park, or other place of	27
<pre>recreation;</pre>	28
(j) A preschool, elementary, secondary, undergraduate, or	29
postgraduate public or private school, or other place of	30
education;	31
(k) A child care center, senior citizen center, homeless	32
shelter, food bank, adoption agency, or other social service	33
<pre>center establishment;</pre>	34
(1) A gymnasium, health spa, bowling alley, golf course,	35
or other place of exercise or recreation.	36
(2) "State agency" means any organized body, office,	37
agency, commission, board, institution, or other entity	38
established by the laws of the state for the exercise of any	39
function of state government.	40
(B)(1) No individual shall be required to wear a mask or	41
other facial covering in any of the following locations:	42

(a) A place of public accommodation;	43
(b) A facility owned or operated by a political	44
<pre>subdivision or state agency;</pre>	45
(c) A court.	46
(2) Nothing in this section shall be construed as applying	47
to a private residence.	48
(C) An individual who believes a violation of this section	49
has occurred may do either of the following:	50
(1) Petition a court of competent jurisdiction for	51
injunctive relief or declaratory judgment.	52
(2)(a) Bring a private civil action in a court of	53
competent jurisdiction for money damages against the place of	54
public accommodation, political subdivision or state agency, or	55
court.	56
(b) If the individual who brings a private action under	57
division (C)(2)(a) of this section proves by a preponderance of	58
the evidence that there was a violation of this section, the	59
court shall award the individual both of the following:	60
(i) Three times the amount of the individual's actual	61
damages or two hundred dollars, whichever is greater;	62
(ii) The individual's reasonable attorney fees and court	63
costs.	64
