BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, The American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE)	4	
stated in its 2021 report card that the United States received a	5	
grade of C- regarding the current state of infrastructure and	6	
that more than six trillion dollars would be needed to restore	7	
the nation's infrastructure to a state of good repair. Over two	8	
and a half trillion dollars is currently not funded, the	9	
remainder is inadequately funded, and all new, twenty-first	10	
century projects remain unfunded; and		
WHEREAS, The ASCE 2021 report card also gave the state of	12	
Ohio a grade of C The state will need to invest at least	13	
twelve billion dollars to upgrade the drinking water systems and	14	
fourteen billion dollars to upgrade waste water systems. More	15	
than six per cent of the state's bridges are rated structurally	16	
deficient, driving on roads in poor repair costs each driver	17

more than five hundred dollars per year, and traffic congestion	18
costs Ohio motorists an estimated four and a half billion	19
dollars each year in lost time and wasted fuel. Rail	20
transportation requires new passenger lines and high speed rail	21
service connecting a Great Lakes system; and	22
WHEREAS, A National Infrastructure Bank (NIB) would be	23
modeled on previous banks that helped build much of our nation's	24
infrastructure, including infrastructure in Ohio. Presidents	25
George Washington, James Madison, John Quincy Adams, and Abraham	26
Lincoln created similar institutions during their	27
administrations that helped finance the roads, dams, bridges,	28
canals, power systems, and railroads that made our nation the	29
envy of the world. The final such institution, under President	30
Franklin D. Roosevelt, helped bring us out of the Great	31
Depression and win World War II; and	32
WHEREAS, Congress introduced H.R. 3339 in the 117th	33
Congress to create a five trillion dollar National	34
Infrastructure Bank; and	35
WHEREAS, A NIB would operate as its predecessors did and be	36
capitalized by existing United States Treasury debt, requiring	37
no new federal spending and no new federal taxes; and	38
WHEREAS, A NIB would create tens of millions of new jobs,	39
pay prevailing wages, and mandate Buy America policies. A NIB	40
would supercharge the United States economy, reopen American	41
production, and grow industry in Ohio. It would ensure robust	42
minority hiring, promote disadvantaged business enterprises, and	43
spawn a resurgence of small business. It would lead to a total	44
factor productivity increase of more than three per cent per	45
year, and a gross domestic product increase of more than five	46
per cent per year; and	47
WHEREAS, A bi-partisan resolution was introduced into the	48
Ohio House of Representatives in the 134th General Assembly.	49

WHEREAS, A NIB is widely supported across the state and the	53
nation. Endorsements include Akron City Council, Toledo City	54
Council, Cleveland City Council, Lucas County Board of	55
Commissioners, Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments,	56
IBEW Local 245, UA Local 50 Plumbers and Steamfitters, Western	57
Reserve Building and Construction Trades, Bricklayers Local 7,	58
All Aboard Ohio, among others. National endorsements include	59
National Black Caucus of State Legislators, National Asian-	60
Pacific Caucus of State Legislatures, Council of State	61
Governments-East, National Association of Counties, National	62
Association of Development Organizers, National Association of	63
Minority Contractors, National Latino Farmers and Ranchers,	64
United Association of Plumbers and Steamfitters Union, and many	65

Representatives, call upon the United States Congress to pass a	68
bill similar to H.R. 3339 of the 117th Congress to create a	69
National Infrastructure Bank; and be it further	70

member of the Ohio congressional delegation, the governor of	73
Ohio, the president of the United States, and the news media of	74
