affiliated with the Republican party that Justin Pizzulli, Republican,	15
having the qualifications set forth in the Ohio Constitution and the	16
laws of Ohio to be a member of the House of Representatives from the	17
90th House District, is hereby elected, effective May 10, 2023,	18
