**A RESOLUTION**

Honoring Hunter Armstrong on securing an Olympic Gold Medal  
in the men's 4x100-meter freestyle relay.

WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 135th

Hunter Armstrong on earning a gold medal in swimming at the 2024  
Olympic Summer Games in Paris; and

WHEREAS, A remarkable individual, Hunter Armstrong has combined  
talent and competitive spirit with the highest ideals of good  
sportsmanship to establish himself as a truly exceptional athlete.  
With admirable dedication, he has worked diligently toward attaining  
ultimate proficiency in swimming, and as a result, he and his relay  
team of Jack Alexy, Chris Guiliano, and Caeleb Dressel won the men's  
4x100-meter freestyle relay race with a dominant time of 3:09.28. In  
addition, he earned a silver medal in the 4x100 medley relay and  
placed eleventh in the 100-meter backstroke at this year's Olympic  
Summer Games in Paris; and

WHEREAS, Hunter Armstrong's outstanding ability and spirited  
drive, as well as his quickness and tenacity, have distinguished him  
as a superior competitor, and for his tremendous performance in the  
2024 Olympic Summer Games, he has gained the admiration and respect of
