Established by F.A. Seiberling in 1924 in her home, Stan Hywet Hall,  
the organization was a founding member of the Garden Club of Ohio and  
an instrumental force in the founding of the Garden Forum of Greater

a leader among its fellow clubs as well as a dynamic force in the  
community; and
