Sec. 4501.21. (A) There is hereby created in the state

treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall19consist of all contributions for specialty license plates paid20by motor vehicle registrants and collected by the registrar of21motor vehicles pursuant to the Revised Code sections referenced22in division (B) of this section.23

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar collects in the fund as follows:

Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends other money in that fund.
