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**A BILL**

To amend sections 4501.21, 4503.53, 4503.583, and 1  
4503.584 and to enact sections 4503.4912, 2  
4503.512, 4503.520, 4503.536, 4503.542, 3  
4503.547, 4503.585, 4503.586, 4503.587, 4  
4503.588, 4503.598, 4503.726, 4503.735, 5  
4503.766, 4503.851, 4503.894, 4503.895, 6  
4503.896, 4503.934, 4503.935, 4503.936, 7  
4503.943, 4503.946, 4503.959, and 4503.965 of 8  
the Revised Code to create and amend multiple 9  
specialty license plates. 10

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That sections 4501.21, 4503.53, 4503.583, and 11  
4503.584 be amended and sections 4503.4912, 4503.512, 4503.520, 12  
4503.536, 4503.542, 4503.547, 4503.585, 4503.586, 4503.587, 13  
4503.588, 4503.598, 4503.726, 4503.735, 4503.766, 4503.851, 14  
4503.894, 4503.895, 4503.896, 4503.934, 4503.935, 4503.936, 15  
4503.943, 4503.946, 4503.959, and 4503.965 of the Revised Code 16  
be enacted to read as follows: 17

**Sec. 4501.21.** (A) There is hereby created in the state 18

treasury the license plate contribution fund. The fund shall 19  
consist of all contributions for specialty license plates paid 20  
by motor vehicle registrants and collected by the registrar of 21  
motor vehicles pursuant to the Revised Code sections referenced 22  
in division (B) of this section. 23

(B) The registrar shall pay the contributions the 24  
registrar collects in the fund as follows: 25

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 26  
pursuant to section 4503.491 of the Revised Code to the breast 27  
cancer fund of Ohio, which shall use that money only to pay for 28  
programs that provide assistance and education to Ohio breast 29  
cancer patients and that improve access for such patients to 30  
quality health care and clinical trials and shall not use any of 31  
the money for abortion information, counseling, services, or 32  
other abortion-related activities. 33

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 34  
receives pursuant to section 4503.492 of the Revised Code to the 35  
organization cancer support community central Ohio, which shall 36  
deposit the money into the Sheryl L. Kraner Fund of that 37  
organization. Cancer support community central Ohio shall expend 38  
the money it receives pursuant to this division only in the same 39  
manner and for the same purposes as that organization expends 40  
other money in that fund. 41

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 42  
pursuant to section 4503.493 of the Revised Code to the autism 43  
society of Ohio, which shall use the contributions for programs 44  
and autism awareness efforts throughout the state. 45

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 46  
receives pursuant to section 4503.494 of the Revised Code to the 47

national multiple sclerosis society for distribution in equal 48  
amounts to the northwestern Ohio, Ohio buckeye, and Ohio valley 49  
chapters of the national multiple sclerosis society. These 50  
chapters shall use the money they receive under this section to 51  
assist in paying the expenses they incur in providing services 52  
directly to their clients. 53

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 54  
receives pursuant to section 4503.495 of the Revised Code to the 55  
national pancreatic cancer foundation, which shall use the money 56  
it receives under this section to assist those who have 57  
pancreatic cancer and their families. 58

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 59  
receives pursuant to section 4503.496 of the Revised Code to the 60  
Ohio sickle cell and health association, which shall use the 61  
contributions to help support educational, clinical, and social 62  
support services for adults who have sickle cell disease. 63

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 64  
receives pursuant to section 4503.497 of the Revised Code to the 65  
St. Baldrick's foundation, which shall use the contributions for 66  
its research and other programs. 67

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 68  
receives pursuant to section 4503.498 of the Revised Code to 69  
special olympics Ohio, inc., which shall use the contributions 70  
for its programs, charitable efforts, and other activities. 71

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 72  
receives pursuant to section 4503.499 of the Revised Code to the 73  
children's glioma cancer foundation, which shall use the 74  
contributions for its research and other programs. 75

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 76

receives pursuant to section 4503.4910 of the Revised Code to 77  
the KylerStrong foundation, which shall use the contributions to 78  
raise awareness of brain cancer caused by diffuse intrinsic 79  
pontine glioma and to fund research for the cure of such cancer. 80

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 81  
receives pursuant to section 4503.4911 of the Revised Code to 82  
the research institution for childhood cancer at nationwide 83  
children's hospital, which shall use the contributions to fund 84  
research for the cure of childhood cancers. 85

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 86  
receives pursuant to section 4503.4912 of the Revised Code to 87  
the Ben Morrison memorial fund, which shall use the 88  
contributions for scholarships and other programs that support 89  
mental health. 90

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 91  
receives pursuant to section 4503.50 of the Revised Code to the 92  
future farmers of America foundation, which shall deposit the 93  
contributions into its general account to be used for 94  
educational and scholarship purposes of the future farmers of 95  
America foundation. 96

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 97  
receives pursuant to section 4503.501 of the Revised Code to the 98  
4-H youth development program of the Ohio state university 99  
extension program, which shall use those contributions to pay 100  
the expenses it incurs in conducting its educational activities. 101

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 102  
pursuant to section 4503.502 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 103  
cattlemen's foundation, which shall use those contributions for 104  
scholarships and other educational activities. 105

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 106  
pursuant to section 4503.505 of the Revised Code to the 107  
organization Ohio region phi theta kappa, which shall use those 108  
contributions for scholarships for students who are members of 109  
that organization. 110

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 111  
receives pursuant to section 4503.506 of the Revised Code to 112  
Ohio demolay, which shall use the contributions for 113  
scholarships, educational programs, and any other programs or 114  
events the organization holds or sponsors in this state. 115

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 116  
pursuant to section 4503.507 of the Revised Code to the Ohio 117  
aerospace institute, which shall use those contributions to 118  
facilitate student internships in aerospace and educational 119  
programming. 120

The registrar shall pay the contributions received 121  
pursuant to section 4503.508 of the Revised Code to the 122  
organization bottoms up diaper drive to provide funding for that 123  
organization for collecting and delivering diapers to parents in 124  
need. 125

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 126  
receives pursuant to section 4503.509 of the Revised Code to a 127  
kid again, incorporated for distribution in equal amounts to the 128  
Ohio chapters of a kid again. 129

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 130  
receives pursuant to section 4503.51 of the Revised Code to the 131  
university or college whose name or marking or design appears on 132  
collegiate license plates that are issued to a person under that 133  
section. A university or college that receives contributions 134

from the fund shall deposit the contributions into its general 135  
scholarship fund. 136

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 137  
receives pursuant to section 4503.512 of the Revised Code to the 138  
Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Incorporated Delta Theta Omega 139  
chapter in Ohio. The Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Incorporated 140  
Delta Theta Omega chapter shall use the contributions for the 141  
development and perpetuation of scholarship, leadership, 142  
citizenship, fidelity, and brotherhood among men and youth in 143  
this state. 144

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 145  
receives pursuant to section 4503.514 of the Revised Code to the 146  
university of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana, for purposes of 147  
awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 148  
the university. The university shall not use any of the funds it 149  
receives for purposes of administering the scholarship program. 150  
The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements with the 151  
university of Notre Dame to effectuate the distribution of such 152  
funds as provided in this section. 153

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 154  
receives pursuant to section 4503.516 of the Revised Code to 155  
Marshall university in Huntington, West Virginia, for purposes 156  
of awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who 157  
attend the university. The university shall not use any of the 158  
funds it receives for purposes of administering the scholarship 159  
program. The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements 160  
with Marshall university to effectuate the distribution of such 161  
funds as provided in this section. 162

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 163  
receives pursuant to section 4503.517 of the Revised Code to the 164

university of Alabama in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, for purposes of 165  
awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 166  
the university. The university shall not use any of the funds it 167  
receives for purposes of administering the scholarship program. 168  
The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements with the 169  
university of Alabama to effectuate the distribution of such 170  
funds as provided in this section. 171

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 172  
receives pursuant to section 4503.518 of the Revised Code to the 173  
Nationwide children's hospital, which shall use the 174  
contributions for the "On Our Sleeves" campaign. 175

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 176  
receives pursuant to section 4503.519 of the Revised Code 177  
equally to NAMI Ohio (national alliance on mental illness of 178  
Ohio), Ohio peer recovery organizations, and OCAAR (Ohio citizen 179  
advocates for addiction recovery). 180

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 181  
receives pursuant to section 4503.520 of the Revised Code to 182  
Purdue university in West Lafayette, Indiana, for purposes of 183  
awarding grants or scholarships to residents of Ohio who attend 184  
the university. The university shall not use any of the funds it 185  
receives for purposes of administering the scholarship program. 186  
The registrar shall enter into appropriate agreements with 187  
Purdue university to effectuate the distribution of such funds 188  
as provided in this section. 189

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 190  
receives pursuant to section 4503.521 of the Revised Code to the 191  
Ohio bicycle federation to assist that organization in paying 192  
for the educational programs it sponsors in support of Ohio 193  
cyclists of all ages. 194

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.522 of the Revised Code to the "friends of Perry's victory and international peace memorial, incorporated," a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of this state, to assist that organization in paying the expenses it incurs in sponsoring or holding charitable, educational, and cultural events at the monument.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.523 of the Revised Code to the fairport lights foundation, which shall use the money to pay for the restoration, maintenance, and preservation of the lighthouses of fairport harbor.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.524 of the Revised Code to the Massillon tiger football booster club, which shall use the contributions only to promote and support the football team of Washington high school of the Massillon city school district.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.525 of the Revised Code to the United States power squadron district seven which shall annually distribute the contributions in equal amounts to all United States power squadrons located in the state. Each power squadron district shall use the money it receives under this section to pay for the educational boating programs each district holds or sponsors within this state.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.526 of the Revised Code to the Ohio district Kiwanis foundation of the Ohio district of Kiwanis international, which shall use the money it receives under this section to pay the costs of its educational and humanitarian



activities. 225

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 226  
receives pursuant to section 4503.528 of the Revised Code to the 227  
Ohio children's alliance, which shall use the money it receives 228  
under this section to pay the expenses it incurs in advancing 229  
its mission of sustainably improving the provision of services 230  
to children, young adults, and families in this state. 231

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 232  
receives pursuant to section 4503.529 of the Revised Code to the 233  
Ohio nurses foundation. The foundation shall use the money it 234  
receives under this section to provide educational scholarships 235  
to assist individuals who aspire to join the nursing profession, 236  
to assist nurses in the nursing profession who seek to advance 237  
their education, and to support persons conducting nursing 238  
research concerning the evidence-based practice of nursing and 239  
the improvement of patient outcomes. 240

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 241  
receives pursuant to section 4503.53 of the Revised Code to the 242  
Indiana Kentucky Ohio regional council of carpenters. The 243  
council shall use the money it receives to assist its members 244  
who are experiencing financial hardship. 245

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 246  
receives pursuant to section 4503.531 of the Revised Code to the 247  
thank you foundation, incorporated, a nonprofit corporation 248  
organized under the laws of this state, to assist that 249  
organization in paying for the charitable activities and 250  
programs it sponsors in support of United States military 251  
personnel, veterans, and their families. 252

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 253

receives pursuant to section 4503.532 of the Revised Code to the 254  
Ohio history connection, which shall use the contributions for 255  
the benefit of the Paul Laurence Dunbar house. 256

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 257  
receives pursuant to section 4503.533 of the Revised Code to the 258  
nonprofit organization Ohio conference of teamsters and industry 259  
health and welfare fund, which shall use the contributions to 260  
further the nonprofit's mission. 261

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 262  
receives pursuant to section 4503.534 of the Revised Code to the 263  
disabled American veterans department of Ohio, to be used for 264  
programs that serve disabled American veterans and their 265  
families. 266

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 267  
receives pursuant to section 4503.536 of the Revised Code to 268  
save a warrior, incorporated, which shall use the contributions 269  
to prevent suicide by active members of the armed forces of the 270  
United States, veterans of those armed forces, and first 271  
responders. 272

~~The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 273~~  
~~receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 274~~  
~~pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 275~~  
~~into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 276~~  
~~be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 277~~  
~~hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 278~~  
~~of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 279~~  
~~destination.~~ 280

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 281  
receives pursuant to section 4503.542 of the Revised Code to the 282

Ohio craft brewers association. 283

The registrar shall pay the contributions that are paid to 284  
the registrar pursuant to section 4503.545 of the Revised Code 285  
to the national rifle association foundation, which shall use 286  
the money to pay the costs of the educational activities and 287  
programs the foundation holds or sponsors in this state. 288

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 289  
receives pursuant to section 4503.55 of the Revised Code to the 290  
pro football hall of fame, which shall deposit the contributions 291  
into a special bank account that it establishes and which shall 292  
be separate and distinct from any other account the pro football 293  
hall of fame maintains, to be used exclusively for the purpose 294  
of promoting the pro football hall of fame as a travel 295  
destination. 296

The registrar shall pay to the Ohio pet fund the 297  
contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 298  
4503.551 of the Revised Code and any other money from any other 299  
source, including donations, gifts, and grants, that is 300  
designated by the source to be paid to the Ohio pet fund. The 301  
Ohio pet fund shall use the moneys it receives under this 302  
section to support programs for the sterilization of dogs and 303  
cats and for educational programs concerning the proper 304  
veterinary care of those animals, and for expenses of the Ohio 305  
pet fund that are reasonably necessary for it to obtain and 306  
maintain its tax-exempt status and to perform its duties. 307

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 308  
receives pursuant to section 4503.552 of the Revised Code to the 309  
rock and roll hall of fame and museum, incorporated. 310

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 311

receives pursuant to section 4503.553 of the Revised Code to the 312  
Ohio coalition for animals, incorporated, a nonprofit 313  
corporation. Except as provided in division (B) of this section, 314  
the coalition shall distribute the money to its members, and the 315  
members shall use the money only to pay for educational, 316  
charitable, and other programs of each coalition member that 317  
provide care for unwanted, abused, and neglected horses. The 318  
Ohio coalition for animals may use a portion of the money to pay 319  
for reasonable marketing costs incurred in the design and 320  
promotion of the license plate and for administrative costs 321  
incurred in the disbursement and management of funds received 322  
under this section. 323

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 324  
receives pursuant to section 4503.554 of the Revised Code to the 325  
Ohio state council of the knights of Columbus, which shall use 326  
the contributions to pay for its charitable activities and 327  
programs. 328

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 329  
receives pursuant to section 4503.555 of the Revised Code to the 330  
western reserve historical society, which shall use the 331  
contributions to fund the Crawford auto aviation museum. 332

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 333  
receives pursuant to section 4503.556 of the Revised Code to the 334  
Erica J. Holloman foundation, inc., for the awareness of triple 335  
negative breast cancer. The foundation shall use the 336  
contributions for charitable and educational purposes. 337

The registrar shall pay each contribution the registrar 338  
receives pursuant to section 4503.557 of the Revised Code to the 339  
central Ohio chapter of the Ronald McDonald house charities, 340  
which shall distribute the contribution to the chapter of the 341

Ronald McDonald house charities in whose geographic territory 342  
the person who paid the contribution resides. 343

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 344  
receives pursuant to section 4503.559 of the Revised Code to 345  
playhouse square, located in Cleveland, Ohio, which shall use 346  
the contributions to further its mission of presenting and 347  
producing a wide variety of quality performing arts, advancing 348  
arts education, and creating a superior destination for 349  
entertainment, business, and residential living. 350

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 351  
receives pursuant to section 4503.561 of the Revised Code to the 352  
state of Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., which shall 353  
deposit the contributions into a special bank account that it 354  
establishes. The special bank account shall be separate and 355  
distinct from any other account the state of Ohio chapter of 356  
ducks unlimited, inc., maintains and shall be used exclusively 357  
for the purpose of protecting, enhancing, restoring, and 358  
managing wetlands and conserving wildlife habitat. The state of 359  
Ohio chapter of ducks unlimited, inc., annually shall notify the 360  
registrar in writing of the name, address, and account to which 361  
such payments are to be made. 362

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 363  
receives pursuant to section 4503.562 of the Revised Code to the 364  
Mahoning river consortium, which shall use the money to pay the 365  
expenses it incurs in restoring and maintaining the Mahoning 366  
river watershed. 367

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 368  
receives pursuant to section 4503.564 of the Revised Code to the 369  
Glen Helen association to pay expenses related to the Glen Helen 370  
nature preserve. 371

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.565 of the Revised Code to the conservancy for Cuyahoga valley national park, which shall use the money in support of the park.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.566 of the Revised Code to the Ottawa national wildlife refuge, which shall use the contributions for wildlife preservation purposes.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.567 of the Revised Code to the girls on the run of Franklin county, inc., which shall use the contributions to support the activities of the organization.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.569 of the Revised Code to the Ohio bird sanctuary, located in Mansfield, Ohio, which shall use the contributions for purposes of its operations, bird care and rehabilitation, and educational programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.576 of the Revised Code to the Ohio state beekeepers association, which shall use those contributions to promote beekeeping, provide educational information about beekeeping, and to support other state and local beekeeping programs.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar receives pursuant to section 4503.577 of the Revised Code to the national aviation hall of fame, which shall use the contributions to fulfill its mission of honoring aerospace legends to inspire future leaders.

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar

receives pursuant to section 4503.578 of the Revised Code to 401  
keep Ohio beautiful, incorporated, which shall use the 402  
contributions towards its mission of empowering Ohio communities 403  
to take greater responsibility for improving the local 404  
environment through litter prevention, beautification, community 405  
greening, waste reduction, and recycling. 406

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 407  
receives pursuant to section 4503.579 of the Revised Code to the 408  
national council of negro women, incorporated, which shall use 409  
the contributions for educational purposes. 410

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 411  
receives pursuant to section 4503.581 of the Revised Code to the 412  
Ohio past detachment commander's club, inc., which shall use the 413  
contributions to support the activities of the organization. 414

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 415  
receives pursuant to section 4503.582 of the Revised Code to the 416  
progressive animal welfare society adoption center, inc., which 417  
shall use the contributions to support the activities of the 418  
center. 419

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 420  
receives pursuant to section 4503.583 of the Revised Code to the 421  
American legion, department of Ohio, inc., which shall use the 422  
contributions to support the activities of the organization. 423

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 424  
receives pursuant to section 4503.584 of the Revised Code to the 425  
Ohio natural energy ~~institute~~ foundation to fund scholarships 426  
for students pursuing careers in the oil and natural gas 427  
industry. 428

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 429

receives pursuant to section 4503.585 of the Revised Code to the 430  
Terrace Park recreation committee, inc. to offer scholarships to 431  
young athletes of, and maintain athletic facilities in, the 432  
municipal corporation of Terrace Park. 433

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 434  
receives pursuant to section 4503.586 of the Revised Code to the 435  
Ohio mountain bike alliance. 436

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 437  
receives pursuant to section 4503.588 of the Revised Code to the 438  
Ohio grange patrons of husbandry foundation, which shall use the 439  
contributions to support the activities of the organization. 440

The registrar shall pay to a sports commission created 441  
pursuant to section 4503.591 of the Revised Code each 442  
contribution the registrar receives under that section that an 443  
applicant pays to obtain license plates that bear the logo of a 444  
professional sports team located in the county of that sports 445  
commission and that is participating in the license plate 446  
program pursuant to division (E) of that section, irrespective 447  
of the county of residence of an applicant. 448

The registrar shall pay to a community charity each 449  
contribution the registrar receives under section 4503.591 of 450  
the Revised Code that an applicant pays to obtain license plates 451  
that bear the logo of a professional sports team that is 452  
participating in the license plate program pursuant to division 453  
(G) of that section. 454

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 455  
receives pursuant to section 4503.592 of the Revised Code to 456  
pollinator partnership's monarch wings across Ohio program, 457  
which shall use the contributions for the protection and 458



preservation of the monarch butterfly and pollinator corridor in 459  
Ohio and for educational programs. 460

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 461  
receives pursuant to section 4503.594 of the Revised Code to 462  
pelotonia, which shall use the contributions for the purpose of 463  
supporting cancer research. 464

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 465  
receives pursuant to section 4503.595 of the Revised Code to the 466  
Stan Hywet hall and gardens. 467

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 468  
receives pursuant to section 4503.596 of the Revised Code to the 469  
Cuyahoga valley scenic railroad. 470

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 471  
receives pursuant to section 4503.597 of the Revised Code to the 472  
Circleville pumpkin show, incorporated, which shall use the 473  
contributions to promote good will surrounding the Circleville 474  
pumpkin show as a nonprofit annual event. 475

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 476  
receives pursuant to section 4503.598 of the Revised Code 477  
equally to the Jackson local schools foundation and the Jackson 478  
high school alumni association. The foundation and alumni 479  
association shall use the contributions for the foundation's and 480  
alumni association's purposes. 481

The registrar shall pay the contributions the registrar 482  
receives pursuant to section 4503.67 of the Revised Code to the 483  
Dan Beard council of the boy scouts of America. The council 484
