motor vehicle registration suspension is removed under division 44  
(A) or (B) of this section may have that individual's driver's 45  
license or motor vehicle registration reinstated at a deputy 46  
registrar office, provided that the individual's driver's 47  
license or motor vehicle registration is not also suspended for 48  
any other offense. 49

(2) If an individual's driver's license or motor vehicle 50  
registration is suspended for another offense, once the 51  
individual's license or registration is eligible for 52  
reinstatement, that individual may apply for reinstatement and 53  
shall not be required to pay any fees, including reinstatement 54  
fees, associated with the suspension removed under division (A) 55  
or (B) of this section. The individual may still be required to 56  
pay reinstatement fees associated with the other offense for 57  
which the individual's driver's license or motor vehicle 58

Removes provisions that reduced to \$25 the reinstatement fee associated with a driver's license suspension for failure to provide proof of financial responsibility. (Thus, returning to the current law reinstatement fees of \$40/\$300/\$600 based on number of prior offenses.)	68 69 70 71 72
Removes provisions establishing a Class F driver's license suspension (until conditions are met) for all suspensions associated with failure to provide proof of financial responsibility.
