opportunities, energy savings, improved traffic safety, and	7

WHEREAS, Smaller, more frequent time changes are likely to	9	
be imperceptible and cause less harm to citizens than changing	10	
the time by an entire hour; and	11	
WHEREAS, States are currently precluded by federal law from	12	
establishing alternatives to Daylight Saving Time (DST). Federal		
law requires the United States Secretary of Transportation to	14	
enforce uniform application of that law across all time zones		
(certain states, such as Arizona, previously opted out of DST);	16	
now therefore be it	17	
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 135th General	18	
Assembly of the State of Ohio, urge the Congress of the United		
States to change DST to "Constant Sunrise Time" by changing the
