Honoring Virgil Strickler on his retirement.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 135th General Assembly of Ohio are pleased to extend special recognition to Virgil Strickler on the occasion of his retirement as general manager of the Ohio Expo Center and State Fair; and

WHEREAS, Throughout his distinguished career, Virgil Strickler has demonstrated an unwavering dedication to performing his duties and fulfilling his responsibilities with the utmost efficiency and competence. Previously working at BancOhio National Bank and the Producers Livestock Association, he became the agricultural director for the Ohio Expo Center and State Fair in 1993, continuing to hold this post while being named assistant general manager in 1998 and general manager in 2004, and he is the longest-running general manager in the history of the fair. During his tenure, he received the Certified Fair Executive designation from the International Association of Fairs and Exhibitions, guided several facility improvements, and started various agricultural education programs, including the nationally-recognized Youth Reserve Program, which has awarded scholarships to more than 44,500 youth exhibitors since its inception in 1995, and he has been accorded numerous accolades, including having the Youth Reserve Program renamed in his honor; and

WHEREAS, Virgil Strickler is, indeed, a remarkable individual, combining civic concern with selfless initiative to become a dynamic leader in Ohio. Always sincere and energetic in his approach to his work, he has given generously of his time and abilities far beyond what was required or expected and has displayed a genuine commitment to improving the quality of life in our society; and

WHEREAS, The enthusiasm and expertise Virgil Strickler has shown

in his endeavors have earned him the respect of all those with whom he 28
