In memory of Scott R. Nein.

WHEREAS, The members of the Senate of the 135th General Assembly 1  
of Ohio are deeply saddened to learn of the death of Scott R. Nein and 2  
extend our heartfelt condolences to his family and friends; and 3

WHEREAS, Scott Nein left an indelible impression on the people 4  
whose lives he touched, and he will be remembered as a spirited 5  
individual who contributed immeasurably to the world around him. 6  
During his political career, he served as a member of the Middletown 7  
Board of Education, the Ohio House of Representatives, where he 8  
advanced to the rank of assistant majority floor leader, and the Ohio 9  
Senate, where he was chairman of the Insurance and Commerce and Labor 10  
committees and also confirmed as dean in 2004. In addition, he was a 11  
former insurance agent, and he was active with the Butler Unit of the 12  
American Cancer Society and the Middletown Chamber of Commerce, Area 13  
Independent Insurance Agents Association, and Rotary Club. Indeed, his 14  
love for Ohio and his sincere desire to serve its people to the best 15  
of his ability have shown him to be a truly concerned and responsible 16  
public servant; and 17

WHEREAS, Scott Nein's regard for improving the quality of life in 18  
our society was clearly evident in his personal sacrifices of time and 19  
effort to his family, friends, and community. Giving generously of his 20  
energy and abilities in all of his endeavors, he displayed exceptional 21

WHEREAS, A devoted husband to his wife, Janis, a loving father to 23  
his four children, Jason, Courtney, Beckett, and Brody, a committed 24  
grandfather to his four grandchildren, Kiptyn, Peyton, Dylan, and 25  
Daxton, and a caring friend to all, Scott Nein always used his talents 26  
to the benefit of others, and the laurels of his life stand as a 27  
tribute not only to him but also to those he left behind. Although the 28  
void his death has created can never be filled, the legacy of care and 29  
commitment he established will surely live on. The world is a richer 30  
place for his having been in it, and he will be sorely missed; 31
