A RESOLUTION

Honoring the Akron Woman's City Club on its One Hundredth Anniversary.

WHEREAS, One hundred years is a distinctive milestone, on which the Akron Woman's City Club can enthusiastically celebrate its mission to enrich its members and the community with philanthropic, educational, cultural, civic, and social activities. Founded on February 8, 1923, this iconic club has overcome challenges that have threatened its standing over the past century, and it has persevered by remaining a relevant resource for the community. Indeed, this fine nonprofit has paid homage to its long and distinguished history through its continued thoughtful and adaptive outreach initiatives to benefit Akron and the surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, One of many reasons that the State of Ohio continues to grow and prosper is because of such organizations as the Akron Woman's City Club. Among its earliest endeavors, the group held benefits for charitable causes, raised funds for hungry children and families in need, and bought wheelchairs for polio patients. Since incorporating itself in 1946 and moving into Grey Lodge, the organization has made the historic property a beloved venue for weddings, banquets, and business meetings as well as a restaurant and home to the Coach House Theatre; and
