**A RESOLUTION**

Honoring St. Aloysius Catholic Church on the Centennial of its building.

WHEREAS, Since its inception, St. Aloysius Catholic Church has offered its members the pathway to a more meaningful life by illuminating and demonstrating the precepts on which the church was founded. After years without their own building, Catholic worshippers in Bowling Green constructed and named their first church in 1881, and the cornerstone for the current structure was laid in 1924 and dedicated two years later.
