Resolutions Reported by Committee

S. R. No. 22 – Senator Schaffer

Cosponsors: Senators Brenner, Koehler, Cirino, DeMora, O'Brien, Weinstein, Smith, Wilson, Wilkin, Patton, Johnson, Craig

To urge the President of the United States, the United States Secretary of Veterans Affairs, and the United States Congress to take prompt action to reduce the processing time for veterans' disability benefit claims.

(Committee on Armed Services, Veterans Affairs and Public Safety recommends adoption March 11, 2025)

Bills for Third Consideration

S. B. No. 63 – Senators Gavarone, DeMora

Cosponsor: Senator Huffman

To amend sections 3501.01 and 5747.502 and to enact sections 3505.011, 3513.141, 5747.504, and 5747.505 of the Revised Code to generally prohibit the use of ranked choice voting and to withhold Local Government Fund distributions from a municipality or chartered county that uses ranked choice voting.

(Committee on General Government recommends passage April 29, 2025)

S. B. No. 95 – Senators Reynolds, Craig

To enact section 5534.428 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of I-71 in Columbus as the "Chief of Police James G. Jackson Memorial Highway."

(Committee on Transportation recommends passage April 30, 2025)

Sub. S. B. No. 158 – Senator Timken

Cosponsors: Senators Brenner, Koehler

To amend sections 3313.753 and 5502.262 of the Revised Code to generally prohibit student cellular telephone use in public schools.

(Committee on Education recommends passage of substitute bill May 13, 2025)

S. C. R. No. 2 – Senator Johnson

Urging Ohio electric utility stakeholders, the Governor, and the Congress of the United States to invest resources into the security, reliability, and resiliency of the state and national interconnected electric grids against natural and man-made threats.
