

Hello,

My name is Nathaniel and I just wanted to give a short testimony in support of H.B. 587. I'm a lifelong Ohio resident and I've had one heck of a ride in this experience called 'life'. I made terrible choices when I was in my early 20s, which led me down a long road full of extensive pain and inexplicable regret. Addiction was my number one enemy. It ruled my life for over a decade and that's not at all hyperbole. But it was just tolerable enough to not puke! When my food had digested about an hour later, I was in disbelief at how much it helped, I was truly shocked. I could think again.. But the best part was that I WASN'T high either. It was like a true 2nd chance. A completely all natural leaf saved my life and gave me back control to where I could fully function in everyday life and not be living in order to just get my next fix. I didn't ever feel the need to overdo it, and I didn't want to overdo it either and there's no negative side effects and so I think everyone who is in that unbearable darkness should have that same opportunity to truly get their lives' back if they want to. Now when it comes down to the other synthetic products that are being extracted and/or purified I have no issues with seeing those go. I've never tried any of them and I don't want to. I know what that kind of stuff leads to and honestly, it's pretty sad that it's so easily accessible. So thank you for allowing me to share my short testimony and I hope this helps everyone to see what dismal decision it would be to criminalize all natural kratom leaf.
