

Testimony of Ann Moorman before the Ohio House Education Committee, Representative Fowler Arther, Chair, February 24, 2025

Chair Fowler Arther, Vice Chair Odioso, Ranking Member Robinson, and members of the House Education Committee:

My name is Ann Moorman, and I am a concerned citizen submitting testimony in opposition to HB96. My family currently benefits from Ohio public schools and we want to keep them as the strong institutions of learning and not weaken the public's access to FREE and APPROPRIATE PUBLIC EDUCATION guaranteed to Americans by law. Not only am I a proud parent of 2 students in the Big Walnut Local School District, I am a proud employee of Columbus City Schools.

I am writing to object the draconian cuts proposed in HB96 which will take crucial dollars out of our public schools. NINETY percent of Ohio students attend public schools.
