Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony. My name is Brittany Hulbert. I am a lifelong Ohioan, a graduate of Ohio's public school system, a mother, and a concerned citizen. I am here today to urge the committee to continue implementing the bipartisan Fair School Funding Plan in Ohio's budget.

For too long, Ohio's public schools have been forced to operate without sufficient resources. Our children deserve schools that are fully and constitutionally funded. The Fair School Funding Plan was years in the making. It was built on extensive research, thoughtful revisions, and bipartisan collaboration.
