Testimony for House Bill 96 House Education Committee March 3, 2025 Lindsey Wyckoff

Chair Fowler Arthur, Vice Chair Odioso, and members of the Education Committee of the Ohio House:

Thank you for allowing me to submit testimony today. My name is Lindsey Wyckoff.

I am a North Canton City Schools Board of Education member and work for the American Cancer Society as the Director, Regional Integrated Marketing. I am writing to you today in support of fully funding Ohio's public schools in the budget bill.

In my previous testimony, I talked about how access to education is a human right. Public education provides individuals from all socioeconomic backgrounds, ethnicities, races, religions, and abilities with the opportunity to gain knowledge, skills, and qualifications that can level the playing field, allowing them to access better jobs, participate fully in society, and overcome barriers related to their origin.
