My name is Jennifer Byerley, and I am 45 years old. I moved to Ohio 14 years ago from Texas. I have a disability.

Before I came to Ohio, my life was very different. In Texas, I didn't have a job. I was told I couldn't do anything on my own. I didn't have access to support, and I had no county board system to look out for me. The family I lived with made me clean their house and never took me out. I felt stuck and unseen.

When I moved to Ohio, everything changed. I began receiving support from Summit DD and was put on the Individual Options (IO) Medicaid Waiver. Because of this, I now live in my own apartment with help, and I have a job at Dollar Tree where I earn minimum wage. I also work as a coach and attend a day program that helps me stay social and enjoy life. The waiver pays for my transportation so I can get to where I need to go.

Thanks to the waiver, I don't have to live in a group home where I might never go out or have a chance to be independent. I have a full, meaningful life. I feel proud of who I am, and I get to live my dreams.

Please protect Medicaid and Medicaid waivers in the state budget. These supports are essential for people like me and my friends.
