Chairman Stewart and fellow committee members,

I have become aware that last week several Republican members chose to include some anti-LGBTQ+ language within H.B. 96 Budget Bill. Specifically, under the Health and Human Services section, they want to add language defining that there are only two sexes. Additionally, under the General Government section, republicans want to require public libraries to hide material related to gender identity from minors.
