

To the committee,

I absolutely oppose this bill as it disenfranchises registered Ohio voters, including military members station out-of-state. In the last three Ohio election, Montgomery County received the following ballots within the 4 day window: Montgomery: 362, 234, and 482. That's approximately 1,000 ballots which would not be counted in Montgomery County under SB293. The totals statewide are even more striking: Ohio: 9,523, 4,107 and 7,266. Is it actually the intent of the Ohio legislature to disenfranchise over 20,000 registered Ohio voters? I urge you to vote NO on SB293.
