Chairman Schmidt, Vice Chair Deeter, Ranking Member Somani, and other Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for accepting my support testimony for HB 12: "The Jeff, Dave & Angie Patient Right Try Act"

I ask you a simple question: When did it become acceptable for bureaucrats and hospital administrators to make life-and-death medical decisions instead of patients and their doctors?
