HB 105 Third Party Litigation Funding

Chair Lampton, Vice Chair Craig, Ranking Member Tims, and members of the House Insurance Committee. My name is Brent Phelan. I'm the President & CEO of Phelan Insurance Agency in Versailles, Ohio. Phelan Insurance is in its' 76th year helping Ohioans with insurance and risk management. I'm also an attorney with experience working on both the plaintiff side and insurance defense side. I'm appreciative of the opportunity to provide written testimony in favor of House Bill 105 and its role in reforming Third-Party Litigation Funding (TPLF) in Ohio.

The consumer protection elements of House Bill 105 should also be commended. The fee disclosure and fee limits established in the substitute bill will protect consumers in a meaningful way.
