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Dear Members of the House Medicaid Committee,

I am a concerned citizen writing to urge you to have compassion on Ohioans who are at 138% of the federal poverty level, especially as it relates to Medicaid health insurance. The proposed cuts to Medicaid expansion coverage will have devastating impacts and could cost lives and the health of our citizens.

A single individual has to make less than \$21,591 and a family of four has an income of no more than \$44,367 to be eligible for Medicaid under the expansion category 8. In Montgomery County alone, 34,484 people will lose coverage if these cuts go through. These individuals rely on Medicaid for essential health services, and without it, they will face significant barriers to accessing the care they need. I implore you to consider the human impact of these cuts and to prioritize the health and well-being of our most vulnerable citizens.
