I am a public school teacher and have been teaching Ohio students for the last 13 years. I am also a mother to a 13 year old, who like countless other Ohio children, dreams of attending the Ohio state university. Unfortunately if SB 1 becomes the state law future Ohio state students ,like my son, will have to dream of attending universities outside of Ohio. This bill will create university environment where professors will not be allowed to challenge students to think critically because this bill will let the government decide what universities are able to teach. By heavily restricting how subjects like climate change and current events are taught you are destroying the purpose of education. The bill also the worst attack on workers rights in over a decade. By removing collective bargaining rights, right to strike you are making it less attractive for qualified and top quality professors to want to come and teach at Ohio universities.
