

Proponent testimony for Senate Bill 147

Whereas the current Ohio Revised Code provides for a county to exit a Solid Waste District, that provision is unworkable and fails to allow a county to exit. This was demonstrated this past year when Seneca County presented a resolution to the Ottawa, Sandusky, Seneca Solid Wasted district requesting to exit the district. Ottawa and Sandusky counties voted unanimously against the resolution as they will do ad infinitum into the future thus shackling Seneca County into a district they oppose.

Senate Bill 147 provides a resolution to this problem for any county wishing to leave a solid waste district. For this reason, I urge you to pass Senate Bill 147 and take it to the full Senate.
