I am writing this today to request your support for the Division of Natural Areas and Preserves (DNAP) portion of the Ohio Division of Natural Resources budget as part of House Bill 96.

DNAP plays a critical role in protecting some of the most unique and ecologically important natural areas in the State of Ohio. These include our beautiful state nature preserves, natural areas, and our scenic rivers that all provide Ohio citizens with opportunities to explore the outdoors, connect with nature, and see the best remaining examples of Ohio's rich natural heritage.
