In 2009, my family was resettled in the United States, where we have worked hard to build a new life. Despite the opportunities we've found here, the trauma of displacement and the longing for justice remain.

I urge this committee to support the resolution recognizing the human rights abuses committed against the Lhotshampa people. Acknowledging these injustices is crucial to healing and ensuring such violations do not occur again.
